

**TOWN OF CROSS PLAINS BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING FEBRUARY 2026**

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Cross Plains held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, February 13, 2026, at 3734 County Road P, Cross Plains and via zoom. Notice of the meeting was posted at the Community Center, Website and Town Garage on February 5, 2026. Board Members Greg Hyer, Patty Mullins, Greg Haack, Paul Correll, Tom Rhude, and Treasurer Bonnie Krattiger and 9 citizens were present. Chairman Greg Hyer called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Patty Mullins led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Minutes of the January 15 and February 3 Board Meetings.

Motion was made by Patty Mullins, seconded by Greg Haack to accept the January 15 Town Board minutes with corrections. All Board Members approved. Motion carried. Motion was made by Patty Mullins, seconded by Greg Haack to accept the February 3 Town Board minutes with corrections. All Board Members approved. Motion carried.

Review of Financial Report and Action on Payment of Bills. The February Financial Reports were reviewed. The list of invoices for payment was reviewed. Motion was made by Patty Mullins and seconded by Greg Hyer to approve payment of invoices in the amount of \$2,841,528.82. All Board Members approved. Motion carried. Motion made by Tom Rhude and seconded by Patty Mullins to approve the transfer of \$68,108 out of the surplus account to the transportation account to pay for the new truck. All Board Members approved. Motion carried.

Chair/Clerk Announcements – Clerk: The Spring Primary Election will be held this coming Tuesday, February 17. **Chair:** The small bridge program that was discussed earlier has a grant program; however, the bridge on Union Valley Road may not qualify. MSA will look into this further. Applications are due in early May.

Public Participation for three minutes on any item. Todd Krattiger wanted to express his feeling on the excavating and culvert replacement project. He is rejecting the proposal due to cost and the expansion of the project. He only wanted the ditches cleaned out to help with the water flow away from homes.

Action on selecting contractor from bids received for the following projects: paving, excavating and culvert replacements on West Mineral Point Road.

Motion was made by Tom Rhude, seconded by Paul Correll to proceed with the CJP Excavating proposal contingent on CJP providing more detailed breakdown of costs for residents, with and for owners to be notified of those costs via email and certified mail. All Board Members approved. Motion carried. Motion was made by Tom Rhude and seconded by Patty Mullins to prepare a preliminary resolution and a document draft report to impose for a special assessment on the ditch project and to retain legal counsel for to review the documents. All Board Members approved. Motion carried.

Discussion-Cross Plains EMS District agreement changes. Town Chairman, Greg Hyer, brought the Board up to date with the meeting with on the recent Cross Plains EMS meeting and what was discussed as far as changes to the district agreement. Population will continue to be used for budget apportionment

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among the municipalities. All parties will continue to work on updating the EMS District agreement.

Action on arranging sale of Town of Cross Plains truck: 2016 Ford F550. Motion was made by Paul Correll, seconded by Patty Mullins to have the 2016 Ford F550 truck be brought to Wisconsin Surplus for sale with an amount of \$65,000 asking reserve price. All Board Members approved. Motion carried.
