It is my understanding as well that the Levins do breed and train Schutzhund dogs. From an Animal Services standpoint, the Levins are currently in compliance with the laws that we enforce. I agree that Zoning may be the best route to address the number of dogs on the property and the kennel/business aspect. The Town Clerk can also address licensing and verify that they have what they need from that angle. Other than that, it would be a noise complaint handled by law enforcement. If there are welfare concerns or the dogs are loose or bite/attack, then we would be happy to address those issues.
