School District

Shall the Mount Horeb Area School District, Dane and Iowa Counties, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$34,000,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school building and facility improvement project consisting of: construction of additions and renovations at the Primary Center, including for classrooms and academic space, a gymnasium, secure entrance and office, and to convert the existing gymnasium into a cafeteria/kitchen; site, playground, parking and traffic flow improvements at the Primary Center; demolition of the Early Learning Center and related site improvements; other capital and building infrastructure improvements at district facilities; and acquisition of furnishings, fixtures and equipment?
