

ORDINANCE FOR REGULATION OF HOURS OF OPERATION  
OF CLASS B ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE  
FOR THE TOWN OF  
CROSS PLAINS, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
SECTIONS 125.10 and 125.68(4)(c)  
WISCONSIN STATUTES

WHEREAS, Section 125.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes provides for any municipality to enact additional regulations for the sale of alcoholic beverages which are not in conflict with Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes;

AND WHEREAS, Section 125.68(4)(c) provides for the regulation of Class B retailers license including a provision for that time of the year in which standard time is advanced under Section 175.095 providing that no premises may remain open between 2 a.m. and 8 a.m. but that the municipality in which the premises are located may establish an earlier closing hour, and that the Town Board has determined that an earlier closing hour is in the best interests of the Township and public;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CROSS PLAINS, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

For the purpose of promoting the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public, and pursuant to Sections 60.18(12), 60.29(13), 125.10 and 125.68(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Cross Plains hereby creates the following regulations regarding the hours of operation of a Class B retailers license for alcoholic beverages:

1. DAYLIGHT SAVINGS HOURS. No premises for which a "Class B" license or permit has been issued may remain open between the hours of 1 a.m. and 8 a.m. during that portion of the year for which the standard of time is advanced under Section 175.095 of the Wisconsin Statutes.


2. JANUARY 1st. On January 1 no premises may remain open between \_\_\_\_\_ 3 a.m. and 8 a.m.


3. STANDARD TIME HOURS. No premises for which a "Class B" license or permit has been issued may remain open between the hours of 1 a.m. and 8 a.m. during other times of the year to which standard time applies as provided by Section 125.68 (4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment and publication or posting as provided by law.


